



## LIGHTING AND REMOVAL AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Keep treated area clean and dry. Any moisture or wetness to the treated area can cause the area to become infected and / or cause the scab to come off too soon, which may lead to a less than desirable results and scarring.
2. Nothing else is allowed in the treated area, such as but not limited to makeup and ointment until complete healing has taken place and the expected scab has come off without interference.
3. If the treated area comes in contact with clothing that causes irritation to the treated area, cover the area as necessary for minimum amounts of time with a non-stick. (Telfa) gauze or dressing. The gauze must allow the skin to breath.
4. Do not try to pick or remove the scab prematurely as this can cause scarring and less ink removal.
5. After the scab exfoliates (comes off the skin) naturally, apply Vitamin E oil every other day until the next session.
6. Client takes full responsibility for following Aftercare Instructions and takes full responsibility if an infection or adverse reaction occurs. If this happens it will affect the results. The technician can be of assistance and is recommended to be contacted for corrective action.
